Vet – all Island residents should use their own vet. (A vet will be on call for mainland competitors)

**Health and Safety:** The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the stewards and officials. Competitors compete at their own risk.

We regret that due to fire and safety regulations no barbecue equipment can be allowed at Dunsbury Farm

**The course may be walked on Saturday, 26<sup>th</sup> August from 2pm to 6pm.**

There can be no admittance to Dunsbury Farm other than at this time.

### **Rules and conditions of entry**

1. This competition will be run under the appropriate rules.
2. Skull cap to current safety standards with chin strap fastened must be worn by anyone mounted. A body protector is compulsory for all competitors.
3. Stop watches are not allowed.
4. **No jewellery is to be worn.**
5. All horses/ponies must be four years and older. Stallions need to be identified in accordance with BSJA rules (i.e. red, white and blue ribbon tied in tail).
6. Please put all litter into the bins provided.
7. Lorries/trailers must not be mucked out onto the field.
8. In all classes the judges/official stewards decision is final.
9. Refund of entry fees will only be made on production of a vet/doctors certificate. In the event of cancellation the organisers reserve the right to withhold a proportion of the entry fees to cover expenses.
10. The organisers reserve the right to cancel/amalgamate/close or otherwise alter classes, times, prizes or any other published information or refuse to accept entries without giving a reason.
11. In the event of elimination on the cross-country course competitors may continue at the discretion of the fence judge but must not obstruct other riders. If asked to leave the course they must do so at walk.
12. Competitors must retire after any fall requiring first aid and will not be allowed in further classes without medical clearance.
13. Misuse of whips, spurs and bits and 'unseemly behaviour' will result in disqualification.
14. Legal Liability – entries are accepted and admission to Dunsbury Farm granted, on condition that save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers, nor the Pony Club, nor the Landowner nor any person acting on their behalf, nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, injury, damage or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever.
15. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.

**Note: Entry to Dunsbury Farm is via the field entrance opposite the entrance to Brook Hill House at the top of Brook Shute.**
