Health and Safety: The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the stewards and officials. Competitors compete at their own risk.

The course may be walked on Saturday, 23rd September from 2pm to 6pm.

Rules and conditions of entry

1. Skull caps to current safety standards with chin strap fastened must be worn by anyone mounted. A body protector is compulsory for all competitors.
2. No jewellery is to be worn.
3. All horses/ponies must be four years and older. Stallions need to be identified in accordance with British Showjumping rules (i.e. red, white and blue ribbon tied in tail).
4. Please put all litter into the bins provided.
5. Lorries/trailers must not be mucked out onto the field.
6. In all races the judges / official stewards decision is final.
7. Refund of entry fees will only be made on production of a vet/doctors certificate. In the event of cancellation the organisers reserve the right to withhold a proportion of the entry fees to cover expenses.
8. The organisers reserve the right to cancel/amalgamate/close or otherwise alter classes, times, prizes or any other published information or refuse to accept entries without giving a reason.
9. Competitors must retire after any fall requiring first aid and will not be allowed in further races without medical clearance.
10. Misuse of whips, spurs and bits and ‘unseemly behaviour’ will result in disqualification.
11. Legal Liability – entries are accepted and admission to the course granted, on condition that save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers, nor the Landowner, nor any person acting on their behalf, nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, injury, damage or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever.
12. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.
